

She was selected for the Artist Residence Association Saint Henri in France, where she further developed her love of painting, working with water colours, oils and acrylics. **Sonia Domenech's** work is framed within abstract symbolism. The circle as a universal symbol and the encounter between the aesthetic philosophy of western and eastern discourse have been a major part of her artistic journey. She is a graduate in Painting from the Royal Academy of Arts in London and a recipient of a DAAD scholarship to study at the Academy Dusseldorf with Gunter Uecker. She has produced paintings, film, installations and collaborative painting projects called Recreations. The sensuous recent works of Marie Joulu, the "Pompeii Series", express her fascination with the relationship between painting and archaeology. Both practices deal with revelations and concealment, using layers of dirt or dust which translate as time. We can envisage archaeologists digging up abstract paintings from a buried museum, with the surfaces of the works concealed by soot, dust and mould. Glitter is used to imitate calcified surfaces but also to elevate it to a high art material and react to light. As if been made by the elements, the wind and rain and time itself, they are revelations in the sense that the perception of the viewer either reveals or conceals the work.

J. Kesín is a German artist based in Spain and the UK, who works mainly with oil and acrylics. Kesín has an MA in Applied Cultural Studies from the university of Lueneburg and more recently studied under the renowned artist and professor Sibylle Werkmeister. In the last few years Kesin has been exhibiting in Spain and his works have started to sell to individual and institutional collectors throughout Europe.

Through associative abstraction and the deconstruction into layers as the carriers of meaning, J. Kesín creates paintings of his perception of subjects that vary from general concepts and social topics to poetry and the autobiographical. Layers can relate to physical aspects, different points in time, feelings, protagonists, .... and they may overlap, disappear, shine through or resurface. This sequential process combines the analytical with the intuitive, with the outcome becoming more than the sum of its parts, revealing the artist's personal conception of his subject. Works on show are from the series 'Stripes'. There can be a myriad of possible interpretations of individual elements and of the paintings as a whole, and the viewer is invited to find their own meaning.

Elizabeth Hefty-Khoury is a London-born visual artist and writer currently based in Valencia, Spain. Holding a MFA in Fine Art from the Art Institute, California, and a MA in Celtic Studies from the University of Wales, her work draws deeply on her interest in literature, history and mythology, and is very research focused. Lebanese by marriage, she has increasingly found herself drawing upon this adopted culture in her work, contrasting it with her own mixed cultural background. Hefty-Khoury's work spans the spectrum from the figurative to the abstract, but common themes and motifs keep reoccurring. She is very interested in cultural dichotomies and conflicts, comparative mythologies, language and text, and gender and how these various elements can be combined.

As a poet as well as a painter, Elizabeth **Hefty-Khoury** is fascinated by the interaction between words and images, how the two forms of expression can bleed into each other, transforming and transformative. Imagined Idioma is a series where words become form, and form becomes words, exploring the expressions of writing and drawing. It is based on an imagined language that expresses emotion in a way that is universally understood. Taking elements from existing, often dead, alphabets – notably Old Irish Ogham, Norse Runes, and Arabic – letters are transformed into abstract forms, a stream of consciousness that defies interpretation beyond that of the viewer.


Geanina Miler, lives and works in La Senia, Castellon. She is a young painter of Romanian - German heritage, with a long artistic career. She demonstrates an innate talent for composition, her figures are integrated into a game of spaces, compartmentalized by color and accurate drawing. Everything is captured in a schematic way, but without breaks, looking for the essential features in a romantic, deep and dense dialogue. She is a member of the Spanish Association of Painters and Sculptors (AEPE), and was elected president of Benicarló Art Association of painters in 2015. In 2015 she was also awarded the medal of honour for the work, Painting is Life (Barcelona). Her paintings have been exhibited in museums and foundations including Fundació Catalunya-La Pedrera, the Coliseuno of Villaviciosa de Odon in Madrid, the Guard Corps of Peñíscola Castle, as well as in Brussels and Romania.

Juan Petry is a Catalan / German artist working in the field of social sculpture. Petry invites people to new creative experiences and the works of art arise through the personal involvement of the participants. Petry has been moving safely in the classic art market and beyond for more than 35 years. He is the founder of the gallery Casa del Dragon, Cervera del Maestre and of the European art network EL-DRAC. More recently he started the first colour garden, as part of sevengardens.eu, a UNESCO certified project in Spain. In 2011, the German-Spanish artist **Juan Petry** exhibited works from the series "Amazing Citizens in Civil Wars" for the first time in a Spanish church. The New World Order, which became a first symbol with the fall of the Berlin Wall, was not the beginning, but a milestone, in the West's efforts to secure their imperial claims, driven by the United States. Wars have always been civil wars. Appropriate or exclude, overwhelm or dehumanize. Those who want war for the sake of peace really want power at any price. Anyone who does not take the human right for himself has already lost it. Empires come and go. What remains are the citizens, who keep building something new out of the ruins, who flee into the caves and then venture out into the open fields again, driven by hunger, courage and love. It is these citizens who, again and again, actually form and promote the community. And as long as they remain in love, one can divide and dominate them.
